

# RENAISSANCE ZONE EXPANSION

## PUBLIC MEETING

The City of Dickinson is holding a public meeting on Wednesday, June 14, 2017 to inform the public of proposed changes to its Renaissance Zone Development Plan and to receive public comment. City Hall is located downtown at 99 2<sup>nd</sup> Street East.

A Renaissance Zone is an economic development tool offering incentives for taxpayers to undertake activities that benefit the City's urban core and the City as a whole.

Dickinson's Renaissance Zone Vision is to enhance the quality of place and grow economic vitality by stimulating new growth and redevelopment. To help the City achieve this vision the following changes are being proposed:

- Change the boundaries of its Renaissance Zone by increasing Renaissance Zone Area from 25 blocks to 37 blocks; and
- Relocate current Renaissance Zone Blocks 1-4 and 21-25.

This notice is being sent to property owners in those blocks proposed for either addition or relocation.
